It was a wonderful evening for all who attended. It is always incredible to have the One Pride family together! We look forward to other events to bring families together in the future!!

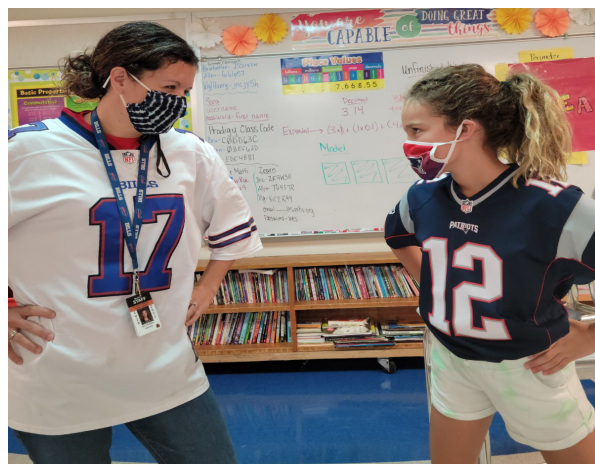
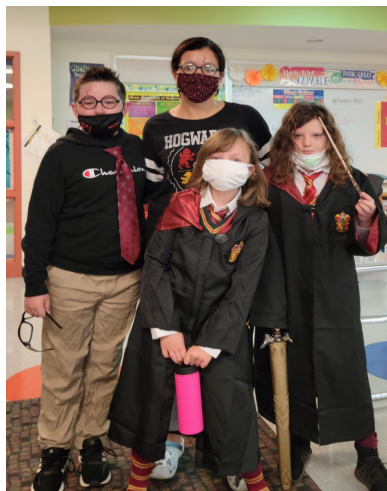


