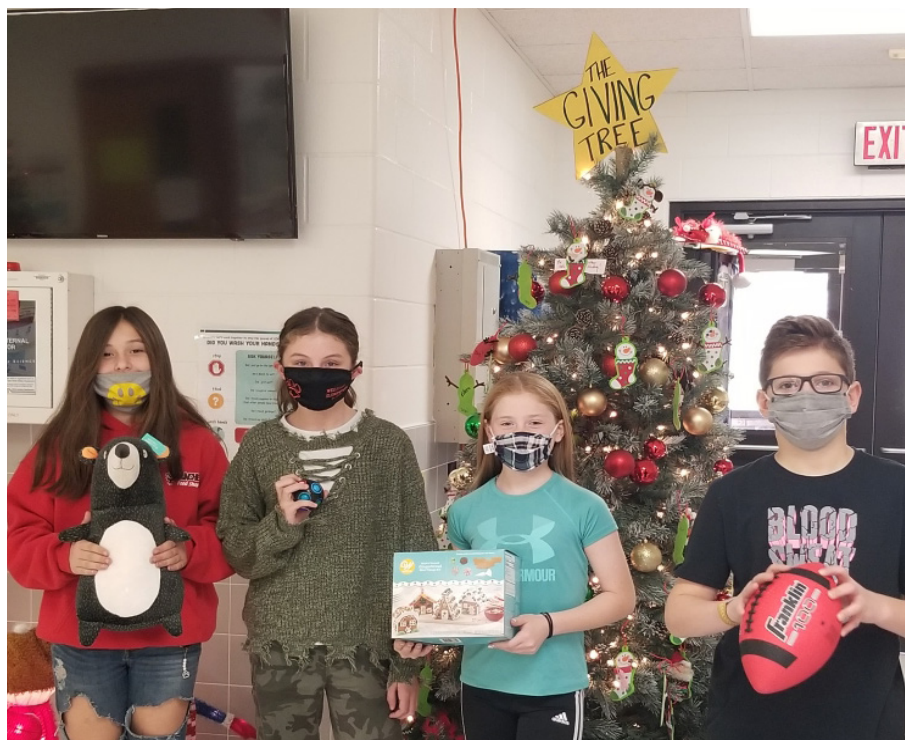

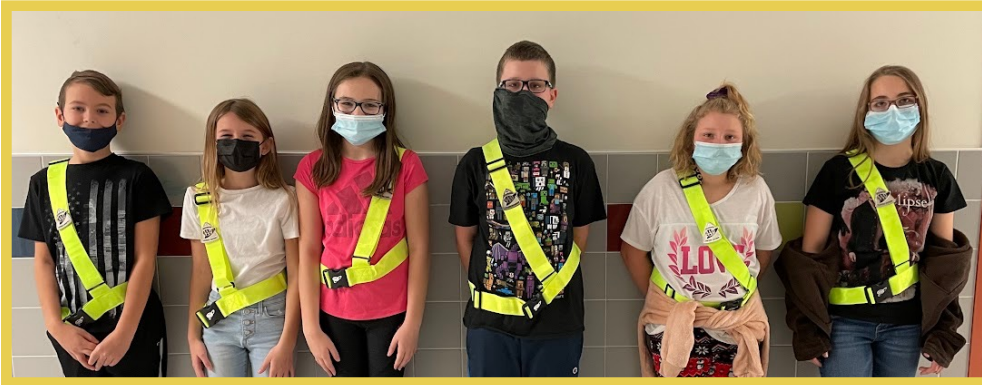

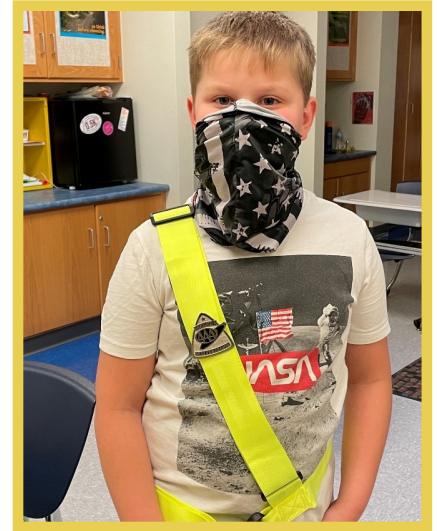

Environmental Science

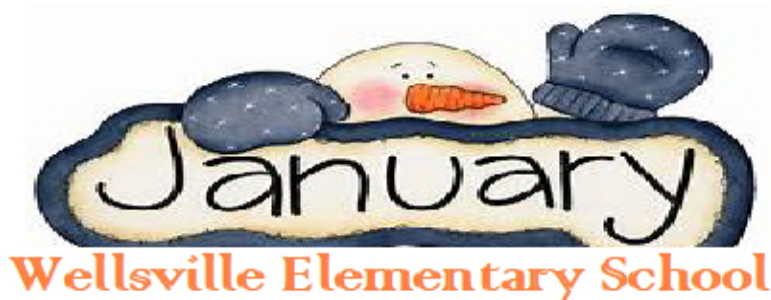

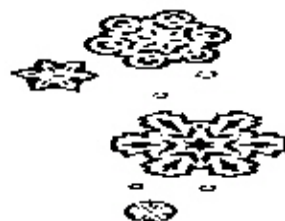

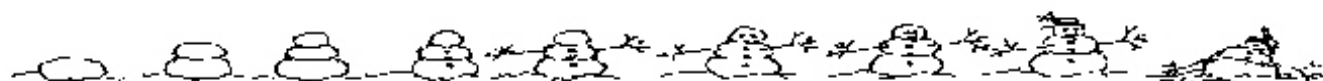
