Musical Theatre Returns to the Secondary School!

Two years ago—and just two weeks before we were due to perform the musical we had been rehearsing for months—COVID shut us down. Following a year without theatre, we have been able to present 2 non-musical productions since last spring. But now it's time to bring a musical back to our stage. The production team has settled on a family-friendly show sure to entertain people of all ages: *A Year with Frog and Toad*. This Tony-nominated Broadway hit is based on the <u>Frog and Toad</u> children's book series by Arnold Lobel.

The show begins in the spring with the return of the Birds (Ellie LaBenne, Maddie Muurisepp, and Felicity Morrison) and the awakening of the hibernating Frog and Toad, played by Gabriel Germain-Tardieu and Ashden Hyslip, respectively. As the show progresses, we see Frog and Toad as they plant a garden, go swimming, bake cookies, fly a kite, rake leaves, tell ghost stories, go sledding, and celebrate Christmas, all the while exploring the meaning and importance of friendship. Along the way, they interact with many of their animal friends, including the Snail mail carrier—

yes, they went there—(played by Ayden Faulkner); the clever and critical Turtle (Megan VanEtten), Lizard (Myya Davis), and Mouse (Izzy Tinder); the playful Squirrels (Rebecca VanBuskirk & Makaila Miess); the mythical Mother, Father and Young Frog (Cori Lunn, Keenen O'Connor, & Aniela Acampora) who must face the Large and Terrible Frog (Tristen Amidon); and the helpful Moles (Liam Rivera & Maddison Baker). Our production is being directed by Matt Warren, with assistance from Vocal Director

Judy Belin, Choreographer Kate Martelle, and Orchestra Director Jeff Joslyn. Mark Corwine will be the show's Prop Master, while Amy Thomas and Sue Ralyea will be our Costumers.

Auditions for the show were held during the second week in January, and rehearsals began immediately thereafter. Our show is set to hit the Wellsville Secondary School Auditorium stage at 7:30pm on April 29th & 30th and at 2:00pm on May 1st. Mark your


