## A proposal to the Wellsville School District Residents:

We have great pride in our school facilities. This district serves as a community hub for both activities and programming, and we have done much to improve our facilities in recent years. This commitment will continue. Wellsville Schools monitors the physical conditions of our facilities through detailed inspections by architects and engineers that are required to be conducted every five years. We have also formed a committee composed of community members and staff and, through their input, identified additional needs ranging from tennis court upgrades (pickleball), turf replacement, bathroom and hallway finish improvements, STEAM additions at the Elementary school, and potential window replacement, to name a few. We prioritized these needs to determine the proposal's content to be presented to voters. The opportunity exists to address these needs while keeping the local tax impact 0%. 


