

Three students from Wellsville Central School attended the New York State Future Farmers of America (FFA) Convention held in Medina on May 8-10. The FFA members from the Cattaraugus-Allegany BOCES Career and Technical Education Center at Belmont attended the convention on Friday, May 9, with advisor and animal science teacher, Carly Neumann, to compete in the Maple Production CDE (Career Development Event) and receive an award for the Chapter Recruitment Challenge.

Chapter members Katelyn Cavagna (Wellsville C.S.), Emmalee Cavagna (Wellsville C.S.), Kylie Hint (Fillmore C.S.) and Ryan Cline (Genesee Valley C.S.) also competed in the Maple Production CDE. Katelyn Cornelius (Wellsville C.S.) represented the chapter on stage for the chapter recruitment challenge. More than 1,000 FFA members competed in 30 events at convention and many more were recognized for competitions and awards earned throughout the year.

The Maple Production CDE is designed to have students understand the impact of maple production in New York State. Participants must be able to identify tools and safety equipment, identify broken or damaged equipment, and recognize sugar bush disorders and multi-use opportunities in the sugar bush. The contest required

students to take a general knowledge test about maple syrup production and they also had to identify equipment. There was also a team event in which the students were given a scenario which required teamwork to complete a task common in the maple industry such as product judging, tubing assembly, or evaporator use. The chapter was thrilled to send students to compete in this contest for the first time.

The chapter also applied for a new award offered this year called the Chapter Recruitment Challenge. This challenge from the 2013-2014 state officer team asked chapters to demonstrate a 15% growth in membership from last year, hold a community outreach event, and write and follow a plan for chapter recruitment that included SMART goals. Last year, the local chapter had no National FFA members and this year they have 16 members. The local FFA members set up a table at the Belmont CTE Center Career Night and spoke with community members about their chapter. While recruiting new members was a challenge, FFA members worked hard this year and they are looking forward to another successful recruiting year next year.

While the school year may be over, things are still going strong with area FFA members as they prepare for summer competitions in livestock, dairy and horse judging, as well as showing beef, horses, goats and rabbits at the Allegany County Fair on July 14-19 in Angelica.
