For elementary and middle school students in the Wellsville Central School District

**What is the program?** The 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center Program is federally funded through a grant that the YMCA was awarded to run an after-school program in the Wellsville Central Schools.

**What is the purpose?** The purpose of the grant is to create or expand community learning centers that provide academic enrichment and youth development opportunities for students in grades K-8 who attend schools that serve a high percentage of low-income families.

**What is our goal?** Our goal is to make sure that all students graduate with the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in college and careers.

**Who can attend?** The program is designed and offered to students in grades K-8 in the Wellsville School District.

**Where & When?** The program will be held after school each day at the Wellsville Elementary and Middle School until 6:00 PM. Busing can be provided for students who need transportation home.

**How do I register?** Enrollment forms are available at the schools, on the school's website, [www.wellsvilleschools.org](http://www.wellsvilleschools.org) or on the YMCA website [www.YourYMCA.org/Wellsville](http://www.YourYMCA.org/Wellsville). **Pre-registration is required and spaces are limited.**

**Is there a cost?** Funding is provided by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Center Learning Grant and is therefore **FREE** to all who attend.
