Wellsville Robotics Teams Advance to States!

On Wednesday, December 21st, the Wellsville Robotics teams competed at the CABOCES VEX Qualifying Tournament at Belfast CSD with coach, Mr. Justin Skrzynski. This year's game, "Spin Up" is played on a 12'x12' square field. Two Alliances – one "red" and one "blue" – composed of two Teams each, compete in matches consisting of a fifteen-second Autonomous Period, followed by a one minute and forty-five second Driver Controlled Period. The object of the game is to attain a higher score than the opposing Alliance by Scoring Discs in Goals, Owning Rollers, and Covering field tiles at the end of the Match.

Pre-K: To be eligible to attend our grant funded Universal Pre-Kindergarten program in September 2023 a child must be **4** years old by December 1, 2023. Student spots are limited! If we have more children signed up than allotted slots, we will proceed with a lottery.

Kindergarten: To be eligible to attend our Kindergarten in September 2023, a child must be **5** years old by December 1, 2023.

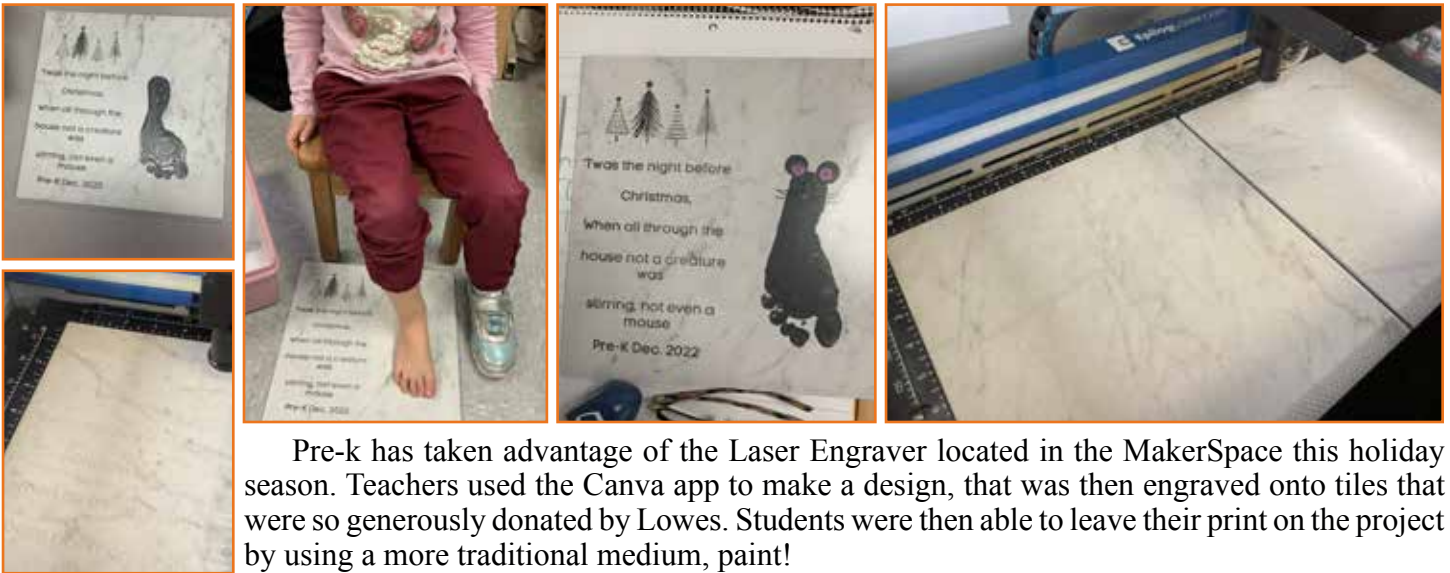

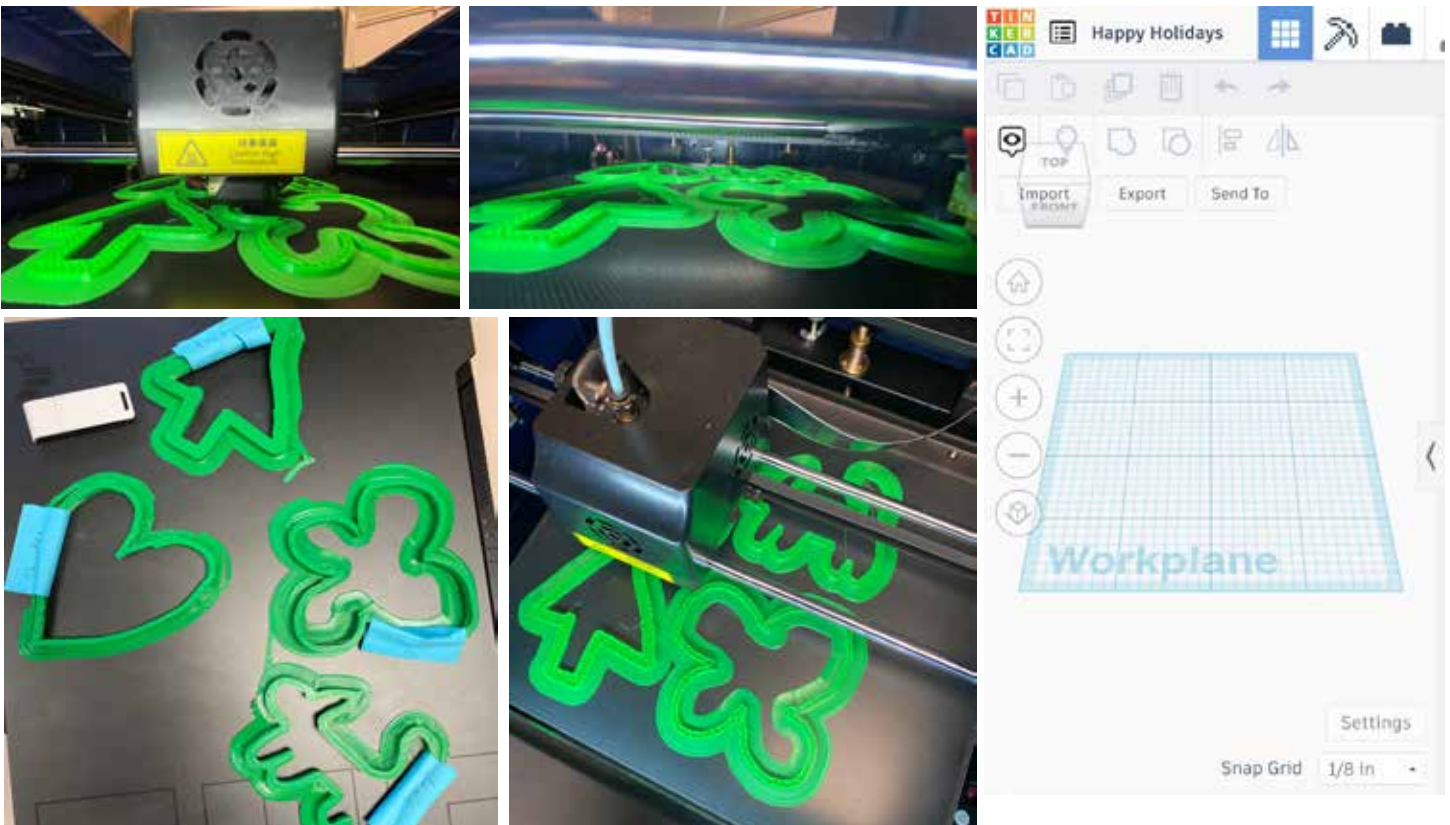

Have you ever wanted to send an experiment into space? In early November, the fifth-grade science club members at Wellsville Elementary School received news that some of their scientific proposals made it to the final round of evaluation for the Student Spaceflight Experiment Program (SSEP). These 10- year olds competed with experiments throughout the Western New York area and teams that ranged from Elementary to High School Students. We recently found out that one of the fifth-grade team's proposals, authored by Adeline Brubaker, Samuel Green, Zia Muska, and Maggie Viglietta, will be joining the program on Mission 17. The student's experiment will be launched in June to the International Space Station and will return to earth after about 4-6 weeks for analysis by the team. We are so proud of these budding scientists and their hard work!




