The Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT/NMSQT) will be given Wednesday, October 11, 2023, to juniors or sophomores who plan to attend college. Outstanding scores are considered for the NMSQT “Commended Scholars” program. Counselors will be meeting with juniors and sophomores interested in taking the PSAT Exam.


