
How to access the Gradebook option

Gradebook Option

- Gradebook is only available for parents to view if they have a student in the Middle or High School
- Once you have logged in and you are on the Home page of your account, follow the directions for accessing assignments in the Gradebook option.

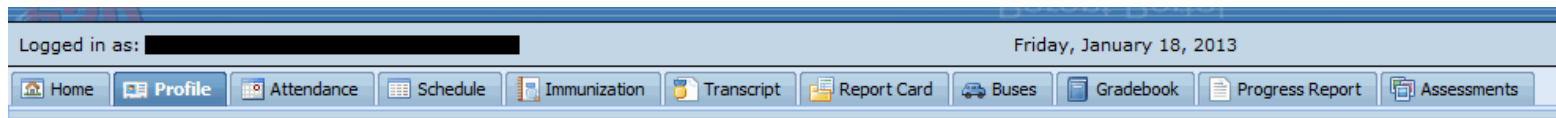
Select your student to view

- Select your student

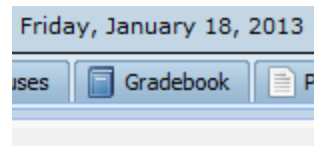

 - Remember, you see more choices for students in Middle and High Schools.




- Select “Gradebook”



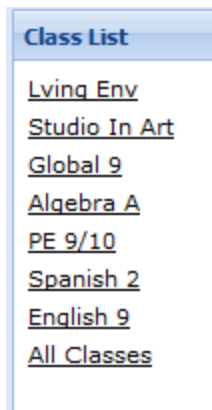
To View Assignments

View Gradebook Assignments

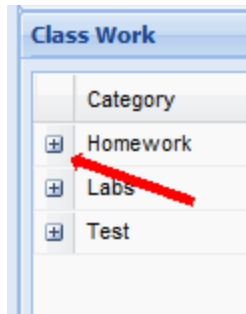
- A list of classes will appear on the left-side



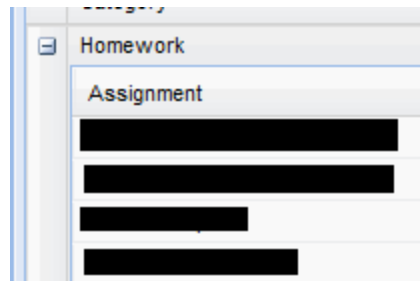
- Select the class you would like to view

 - To view the individual assignments, you then click the + symbol



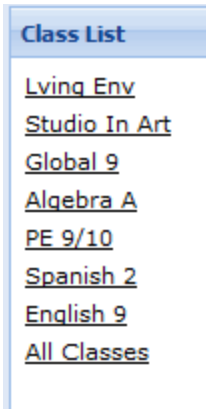
- The category will then expand to show the assignments




Overall Marking Period Average
